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REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT

To the management of CertiPath, Inc. ("CertiPath"):

Scope

We have examined the assertions by the management of <u>CertiPath</u> and <u>DigiCert, Inc.</u> ("DigiCert"), an independent subservice organization that provides Public Key Infrastructure ("PKI") management services to CertiPath, that for its Certification Authority ("CA") operations at California and Utah, in the United States of America, throughout the period November 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020 for its CAs enumerated in <u>Attachment B</u>, CertiPath and DigiCert have:

- disclosed CertiPath's business, key lifecycle management, certificate lifecycle management, and CA environmental control practices in applicable versions of its CertiPath X.509 Certificate Policy ("CP") (including sections 1 through 9), CertiPath CBCA Certification Practice Statement ("CBCA CPS") and CertiPath CRCA Certification Practice Statement ("CRCA CPS") (collectively the "CPSs") (including sections 1 through 9), and Memorandum of Agreement between the United States Federal Public Key Infrastructure Policy Authority and CertiPath, Inc. ("MOA") (including sections 1 through 9), as enumerated in Attachment A
- provided its CA services in accordance with its disclosed practices, including:
 - CertiPath's CP (including sections 1 through 9)
 - CertiPath's CBCA CPS and CRCA CPS that are consistent with CertiPath's CP (including sections 1 through 9); and
 - o the MOA (including sections 1 through 9)
- maintained effective controls to provide reasonable assurance that:
 - the integrity of keys and certificates it manages is established and protected throughout their lifecycles; and
 - subordinate CA certificate requests are accurate, authenticated, and approved
- maintained effective controls to provide reasonable assurance that:
 - logical and physical access to CA systems and data is restricted to authorized individuals;
 - o the continuity of key and certificate management operations is maintained; and
 - CA systems development, maintenance, and operations are properly authorized and performed to maintain CA systems integrity

based on the WebTrust Principles and Criteria for Certification Authorities v2.2.

CertiPath does not escrow its CA keys, does not provide subscriber key lifecycle management controls, does not provide subscriber registration, and does not provide certificate suspension services. Accordingly, our examination did not extend to controls that would address those criteria.



Certification Authority's Responsibilities

CertiPath and DigiCert management are responsible for their respective assertions, including the fairness of their presentation, and the provision of their described services in accordance with the WebTrust Principles and Criteria for Certification Authorities v2.2.

Practitioner's Responsibilities

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Those standards require that we plan and perform the examination to obtain reasonable assurance about whether management's assertions are fairly stated, in all material respects. An examination involves performing procedures to obtain evidence about management's assertion. The nature, timing, and extent of the procedures selected depend on our judgment, including an assessment of the risks of material misstatement of management's assertions, whether due to fraud or error. We believe that the evidence we obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

The relative effectiveness and significance of specific controls at CertiPath and DigiCert and their effect on assessments of control risk for subscribers and relying parties are dependent on their interaction with the controls, and other factors present at individual subscriber and relying party locations. Our examination did not extend to controls at individual subscriber and relying party locations, and we have not evaluated the effectiveness of such controls.

Inherent Limitations

Because of the nature and inherent limitations of controls, CertiPath's and DigiCert's ability to meet the aforementioned criteria may be affected. For example, controls may not prevent, or detect and correct, error, fraud, unauthorized access to systems and information, or failure to comply with internal and external policies or requirements. Also, the projection of any conclusions based on our findings to future periods is subject to the risk that changes may alter the validity of such conclusions.

Independent Accountant's Opinion

In our opinion, throughout the period November 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020, CertiPath's and DigiCert's management assertions, as referred to above, are fairly stated, in all material respects.

This report does not include any representation as to the quality of CertiPath's or DigiCert's services other than its CA operations at California and Utah, in the United States of America, nor the suitability of any of CertiPath's or DigiCert's services for any customer's intended purpose.



Other Matters

Without modifying our opinion, we noted the following other matters during our procedures:

Matter Topic	Matter Description
Subordinate CA and Cross Certificate Lifecycle Management	The CertiPath Policy Management Authority agreed to accept temporary documentation in place of a full compliance report for one organization that was not able to complete its engagement in a timely manner due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related travel restrictions.

The World Health Organization classified the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic in March 2020. Based on the continued increase in exposure globally, the gravity or length of the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak cannot be estimated at this time.
